- 11.3.1. The Library Board may undertake fundraising activities to enhance the services and facilities of the Library.
- 11.3.2. All funds raised will be used for the stated purposes and established priorities of the fundraising program as determined by the Library Board. Funds will be used as designated by the donor, subject to Library Board approval.
- 11.3.3. Use of funds raised for fundraising operating expenses will be with Canada Revenue Agency's guidelines. Every effort will be made to maximize funds raised in relationship to dollars spent.
- 11.3.4. Tax receipts will be issued for money received through fundraising in accordance with Canada Revenue agency's guidelines.
- 11.3.5. Donations raised through fundraising will be recognized as laid out in the Recognition section of the Donations policy.
- 11.3.6. All research on established and potential donors will be confined to information relative to the cultivation and solicitation process. Research methods will respect the individual's right to privacy.
- 11.3.7. All records pertaining to established and potential donors will be held confidentially and in accordance with the Protection of Privacy policy.
