- 2.3.1. The Inaugural Meeting normally occurs at the first scheduled Library Board meeting of the year, or at the first scheduled meeting following the appointment of new members of the Library Board for the current term.
- 2.3.2. The Chief Librarian calls the meeting to order and conducts the meeting until the election of the Chair.
- 2.3.3. Nominations will be taken from the floor for the election of the Chair and Vice Chair. Consent of the nominee, in person or in writing, is required.
- 2.3.4. Elections will be by majority vote of the Library Board members present. If there is only one nominee, the individual will be declared elected by acclamation.
- 2.3.5. The Library Board members present shall first elect the Chair then the Vice Chair. The Chair and Vice Chair serve until the next Inaugural Meeting and are eligible for re-election.
