6.2.	Responsibility for Selection

6.2.1. While overall responsibility for library collections rests with the Library Board, the responsibility for selection of materials rests with the Chief Librarian.

6.2.2. The Chief Librarian may delegate this professional activity to qualified and knowledgeable staff.

6.2.3. New Formats

6.2.3.1. Qualified staff will evaluate new technology and formats in the context of budget considerations, community needs, impact on existing resources, and suitability for a public library.

6.2.3.2. The selection of material in a new format may result in the Library deciding to retire specific items or material formats from its collections to responsibly accommodate trends in user demands and/or changes in technology.
